1. Go to Control Panel and open Internet Options. Or, go to Internet Explorer and click on the settings wheel and open Internet Options.



2. Click on the Security tab, click on Trusted Sites and then click the Sites button.



3. Add https://vpn.emreverywhere.com to the trusted sites list.
